## "SHARING THE GOSPEL - PART 2"

**Text:** Romans 1:16 – "For I am not ashamed of the gospel, for it is the power of God for salvation to everyone who believes, to the Jew first and also to the Greek."

- **I. Keep it simple.** The gospel is NOT complicated.
- II. Memorize the 5 verses of the Romans Road.
  - A. Rom. 3:23 For all have sinned and fall short of the glory of God.
  - B. Rom. 5:8 "But God shows his love for us in that while we were still sinners, Christ died for us."
  - C. Rom. 6:23 "For the wages of sin is death, but the free gift of God is eternal life in Christ Jesus our Lord."
  - D. Rom. 8:1 "There is therefore now no condemnation for those who are in Christ Jesus."
  - E. Rom. 10:9 "Because, if you confess with your mouth that Jesus is Lord and believe in your heart that God raised him from the dead, you will be saved."
- III. Study them until you understand their meaning.
- IV. Pray God will give you a greater love for others.
- V. Write out your testimony. Revise it until you are comfortable that you are sharing the right words and doctrine.
- VI. Don't argue with others. You can't argue people to faith in Christ.
- VII. Pray Christ will be glorified in your witness.
- VIII.Live what you say you believe.

## **Summarizing the Gospel**

We are all born sinners and fall short of God's glory and standard. We must be saved from the wrath of a holy God. The wages of our sin is death. This is really bad news because we either pay this penalty for all of eternity or somebody has done it on our behalf.

Here is the great news. To those who are in Christ, there is and never will be any condemnation, guilt, or shame. The Bible is clear that if we confess our sins and believe in our heart the Gospel message, plus nothing or minus nothing, we will be saved. The results of that will be a complete transformation by God.
